## COVID VACCINE CLINIC AT THE QUEEN'S CONFERENCE CENTER EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The following Emergency Procedures are authorized at the COVID Vaccine Clinic at The Queen's Conference Center:

- 1. For emergencies prior to cardiopulmonary arrest, the Rapid Response Team (RRT) will be activated and all RRT protocols will be authorized.
- 2. Code Blue will be activated for cardiopulmonary arrest and as per RRT protocols/procedures. All Code Blue protocols will be authorized.
- 3. At the same time that the Code Blue is activated, 911 will be called to facilitate transport.
- 4. A code cart, with an AED instead of a defibrillator, will be available in the clinic.
- 5. A wheelchair will be available in the clinic.
- 6. Medications to specifically treat anaphylaxis will be available in the clinic.
